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Overview of Training

Safeguarding Children Training provides a comprehensive range of ‘best value’ courses on a variety of Child Protection and Safeguarding related subjects (Levels 1 to 5), e.g., Introduction to Safeguarding Children, Multi-Agency Working, Child Sexual Exploitation.

Our training courses are classroom based face-to-face, incorporating group discussion and activities to enable shared experiential learning.

Training is designed for all practitioners and managers working in professional capacity with children and/or providing services for children and/or their families.

<p>Safeguarding Children</p> <p><i>‘Everybody’s Responsibility’</i></p> <p>Universal Level 2</p>	<p>This training is aimed at those working with children.</p> <p>Please note: Universal Safeguarding needs to be renewed every 3 years.</p>
<p>Multi-Agency Safeguarding Children</p> <p><i>‘Working Together’</i></p> <p>Targeted Level 3</p>	<p>This training is aimed at those professionals who regularly work one to one or unsupervised with children (i.e., hub workers, Health Visitors, SEN teachers and GPs).</p> <p>Please note: Targeted Safeguarding training needs to be renewed every 3 years.</p>
<p>Designated Safeguarding Children Lead</p> <p><i>‘Keeping Children Safe’</i></p> <p>Targeted Level 3/4</p>	<p>This training is aimed at Designated / Named Safeguarding Leads / Officers within a school / setting / organisation that have leadership or management responsibilities to safeguarding children within their role. The course will cover in-depth information on safeguarding responsibilities.</p> <p>Please note: Designated Safeguarding Lead Training needs to be renewed every 2 years.</p>

All training incorporates the requirements of the Children Acts 1989 and 2004 along with all statutory guidance such as; 'Keeping children safe in education' and 'Working together to safeguard children'.

Courses can be delivered on a date of your choice or delegates can attend our pre-scheduled courses organised throughout the year. Timings are either between 9:30 - 13:00 or 9:30 - 16:30 dependant on the type of course. Refreshments are provided throughout the day, however lunch is not provided for any course.

Core Safeguarding Children Courses

Safeguarding Children *'Everybody's Responsibility'* Universal Level 2 Course

Length of Course: 3.5 hours (delivered between 9:30 – 13:00)

Cost: From £27.50 per delegate or £240 half day rate.

Please note: This course needs to be renewed / updated every 3 years.

This is for all professionals who work with children and/or their families. Training is valid for up to 3 years. This is prerequisite to the Targeted and the Designated Lead course.

Target Audience:

This training is aimed at those working with children. For school and early years settings all staff will require this level training as a minimum due to additional safeguarding guidance applicable.

Aim:

To raise awareness about your roles and responsibilities in relation to safeguarding children and young people within your organisation.

Key Objectives:

- Describe what is meant by 'safeguarding';
- State who to consult within your agency;
- Identify what to do if you are concerned about a child;
- Demonstrate an awareness of current protocols and procedures;
- Recording and Reporting

Multi-Agency Safeguarding Children 'Working Together' Targeted Level 3 Course

Length of Course: 7 hours (delivered between 9:30 – 16:30)

Cost: From £60 per delegate or £460 day rate.

Please note: This course needs to be renewed / updated every 3 years.

This course is Targeted (Level 3) and has been designed for professionals working with children and/or parents/carers, who could potentially contribute to assessing, planning, intervening, investigating, supervising and evaluating the needs of children where there are safeguarding / child protection concerns.

Target Audience:

The Targeted Safeguarding Training is for staff who regularly work unsupervised with any children.

Aims:

- To help practitioners think critically and carefully about child protection cases;
- To feel more confident in carrying out the responsibilities for safeguarding in your role;
- To provide opportunities for people to learn and work together, exploring professional dilemmas in an inter-agency context.

Key Objectives:

- Describe the roles of other agencies in safeguarding children;
- Describe how you may manage a complex situation;
- Demonstrate an understanding of safeguarding procedures.

Designated Safeguarding Children Lead Targeted Level 3/4 Course

Length of Course: 7 hours (delivered between 9:30 – 16:30)

Cost: From £75 per delegate or £460 day rate.

Please note: This course needs to be renewed / updated every 2 years.

This Designated Lead course is a specialist level (Level 3/4) and is designed to promote a positive culture of safeguarding and to develop multi-agency partnership working practice.

This course is specifically for designated/deputy safeguarding leads/officers of settings, schools and practices.

The Designated Lead training is for staff with leadership or management responsibilities for safeguarding children within their role and/or are the named lead/designated professional for their organisation/setting.

Aim:

To help Designated Leads to think critically and carefully about the management of child protection issues in their setting and feel more confident in carrying out the responsibilities of the Designated Lead.

Key Objectives:

- Explain the roles and responsibilities of a Designated /Lead Practitioner;
- Describe the roles of other agencies in safeguarding children and good inter-agency working;
- State how you may manage a complex situation within your agency; demonstrating an understanding of escalation processes;
- Describe how you may support staff.

Specialist Safeguarding Children Courses

E-Safety: Protecting Children Online

Length of Course: 3.5 hours (delivered between 9:30 – 13:00)

Cost: From £27.50 per delegate or £240 half day rate.

This introductory course (L2) is for participants working with children to understand the context, meanings and information to enable them to safeguard children from cyber enabled abuse.

Aims/Objectives:

- Explore the potentials, opportunities, uses and risks of ICT.
- Understand the legislation pertaining to ICT, including Data Protection Act for privacy, and the Sexual Offences Act 2003 designed to protect children from sexual exploitation on the Internet.
- Explore the continuum for safeguarding children on the internet, including risk-taking behaviours and child abuse
- Identify tactics used by paedophiles and sexual predators on the Internet
- Explore the signs and symptoms of cyber-abuse

Managing Safeguarding Allegations

Length of Course: 3.5 hours (delivered between 9:30 – 13:00)

Cost: From £27.50 per delegate or £240 half day rate.

This specialist course (L3/4) aims to assist delegates in dealing effectively with safeguarding allegations against staff and promoting safe working practice by staff, thereby reducing the risk of allegations of inappropriate conduct and harm to children. The training will equip practitioners to understand the context and their responsibilities when safeguarding children.

Aims/Objectives:

- Identify the process for managing allegations in accordance with Child Protection Procedures
- Understand what constitutes an allegation, how allegations arise and the process of allegations management, including the roles of Line Managers, HR Manager,

Designated Safeguarding Manager/Lead and the Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO)

- Identify areas of vulnerability in staff practice and develop ideas about how to address these vulnerabilities
